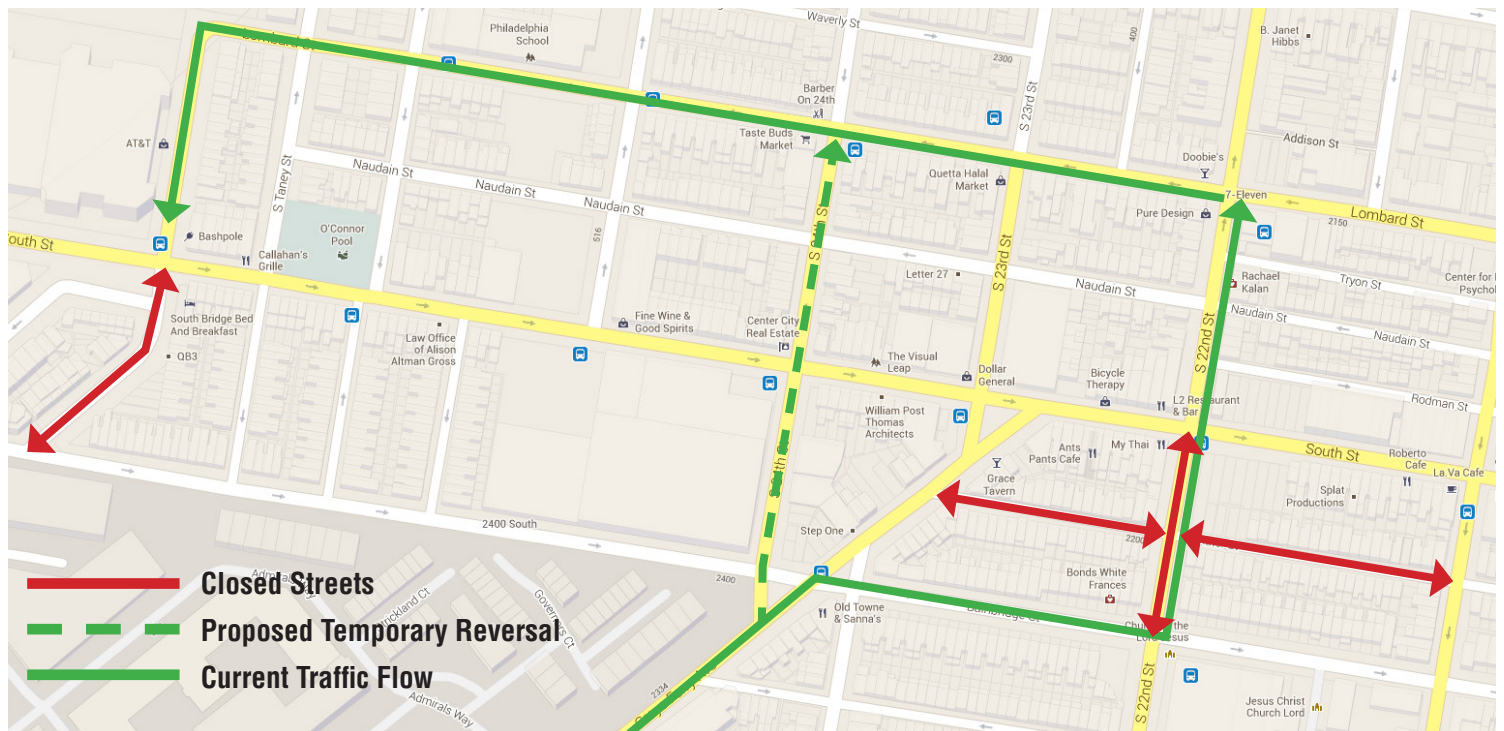


# ATTENTION NEIGHBORS: Public Meeting on Reversal of 24th Street this Summer

When: Thursday, June 13th, 5:30 Sharp – 6:30 PM

Where: The Philadelphia School, 25th & Lombard Street



The Water Department is doing extensive sewer and pipe work this summer that will greatly impact traffic and likely cause much congestion. Sewer pipe replacements will take place on the 2100 & 2200 blocks of Kater Street, and 22nd & 27th Streets between Bainbridge & South Streets.

To alleviate the congestion that will result from this work, which could last up to 200 days, *the Streets Department has proposed temporarily reversing 24th Street from Grays Ferry Avenue to Lombard Street to northbound instead of southbound.*

Streets asked SOSNA, CCRA and the SSWBA to hold a public meeting with neighbors and businesses that will be impacted by this reversal where Streets Department and Water Department personnel will discuss the proposal. **Please join us on June 13th to make your voice heard.**
